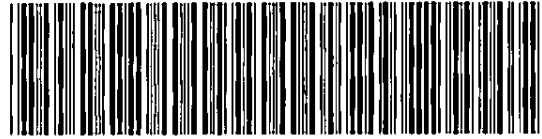





**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR:
UNIDOS EN LA MISION FOUNDATION, INC.**

ARTICLE III – PURPOSE:

To operate exclusively for such charitable, scientific and education purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or under any corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, covering the distributions to organizations qualified as tax exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, including private foundations and private operating foundations.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized or empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this article. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

To coordinate and promote a wide network of alumni, friends, benefactors, volunteers, institutions and companies that are committed to integral education which will have as main objectives:

To create a network of alumni and friends in the United States.

To develop a transparent, efficient and reliable management model that allows mobilizing resources for the charitable works of the Company of Jesus in the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela.

To offer a fundraising platform through campaigns, activities and charity events.

To promote a culture of solidarity and co-responsibility in the Venezuelan population, inviting others to support with talents, resources and ideas.

To promote a model of education that prepares low-income students to be eligible to participate in exchange programs with other educational institutions in the United States.

To provide information about educational projects, works and achievements of the Company of Jesus to its alumni and friends residing in the United States.

To promote inter-institutional relations between educational institutions in Venezuela and in the United States to allow academic exchange and the development of joint projects of training and research.

To obtain contributions to expand scholarship funds and finance institutional development projects and acquire high quality supplies, materials and technologies in the United States.

To carry out all types of charitable activities, promoting solidarity and raising resources to strengthen the management of the organizations and the sustainability of the initiatives and charitable works of the Company of Jesus in the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela.

To strengthen the management and sustainability of the Jesuit service mission in the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, through strategies that respond effectively to the apostolic priorities of the mission in Venezuela and the needs of the country.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
